- Answered a query regarding staff morale, said staff are being professional, polite, empathetic, awesome all around, keeping heads up and always looking for ways to build community within the school
- Answered a query asking if staff are ready for online teaching if a school closure happens, said teachers are ensuring that Google classroom is up and running so most are ready to go.
- Absenteeism is low amongst staff is low and they are staying home when unwell
