Dry Grad update: Suzana Topic



Principal's Update

- Regular enrollment is down about 15 students so far. We are expecting up to 55
 international students, we might get more, we might get less. We have 23 right now.
- Going over our course selection and looking to see if we need to cancel any courses and shift student requests. We must match staffing to course selection.
- AP assessment in May Art and Psychology
- Continue to plan for next year, staffing, scheduling, etc
- Weekly update email to parents/guardians
- PAC spending for vulnerable students is underway. We might buy gift cards with some of the money to support families but also to allow us to have food for September and October.
- Grad newsletter went out to families and grads things being organized, valedictory, walk across the stage speech, working with Grads BC
- Scholarship applications have a due date of April 27
- Still working on what a schedule will look like next year. Likely quarters, learning groups, morning prep for staff, and flex block. District is going to give us some parameters. We need the flexibility to move through the stages.
- We are getting three PC computer labs upgraded the spring/summer

- A steady stream of COVID early exposure notices. We currently have students in self-isolation by Fraser Health and some by family self-isolation.
- We are fully over to Outlook and Teams.
- PAC might want to move to Teams and off of Zoom at the end of the year.

- We created new t-shirts and used some of the PAC money for staff appreciation.
