Informal Update

If a family does not receive any Informal Update reports from their child's teachers, then the family can assume their child is achieving greater than 60% or is higher on the Proficiency Scale. Take Our Kids to Work – Wednesday, November 1st

 This year families may participate in having their child visit their workplace on November 1st. We are expecting the vast majority of grade 9 students to attend a work site. For students who do not participate, there will be an alternative assignment in the library for the day.

Provincial Assessments

Feeding Futures Grant

 - Food costs for Culinary Arts programs, if the food produced by the program is provided to students in need.
 - Grocery store gift cards for students who need them most.
