#### THE "INSTITUTES"

#### **BCIT**

- Offer 1,2 and 4 year programs each having specific requirements
- Diplomas and degrees in Applied & natural Sciences, Business & Media, Computing & IT, Engineering, Health Sciences, and Trades
- Many programs are competitive grades above the academic minimum, some post secondary credits required, related work experience, etc.
- Many trades programs have waitlists.
- Apply early

#### ADMISSION AVERAGES

#### RESEARCH UNIVERSITIES

5-6 academic/non-academic Grade 12 courses 87% and higher

#### TEACHING UNIVERSITIES/COLLEGES

The academic requirements are different for each program and school. Sometimes the website says "General Admission Requirements: Graduation from high school with English 12 "C" or "C+" however students need to dig a little deeper into the high-school pre-requisites for each class they will be taking.

- ► English 11 and 12
- ► Language 11 (<u>May</u> be an Introductory Language 11)
- Pre-Calculus 11 or Foundations of Math 11
- Science 11
- Social Studies 11 or 12
- ► 5 APPROVED ACADEMIC GRADE 12 COURSES ARE NEEDED



#### WHAT IS AN APPRENTICESHIP?

An apprenticeship is a form of post-secondary education that combines paid, work-based training with technical training in a classroom or shop setting. You need BOTH to become a Red Seal Journeyperson.

## SKILLEDTRADESBC

Leads and coordinates British Columbia's skilled trades system.



### FUNDING AND CREDENTIALS

They issue credentials, support apprenticeships and they also fund programs.



## LIASE WITH INDUSTRY

Works with employers, apprentices, industry, training providers and government.



#### PROGRAM STANDARDS

70% or higher is required for successful completion.

- 480 hours of paid work

- Grades 10-12

- 4 8 Graduation Credits(1 or 2 elective credits)
- Identify a career focus or goal. Example: carpenter, doctor, accountant, social worker, artist, travel agent...)
  - Select ONE focus areas that best relates to your career plans.

# Drafting (CADD) Dual Credit

- If accepted the school district will pay the tuition.
- 4 Kwantlen courses in total
- September to May: 2 nights a week,
  - Tuesday AND Thursday, 4-7 p.m.
- May June: 1 night a week
  - Tuesday OR Thursday (TBD), 4-10 p.m.,
     plus online component
- Apply before spring break.



#### **Early Childhood Education**

- Successful completion = apply for certified **ECE** Assistant
- Last week of June end of July
- Student must be registered in a Delta school & entering either grade 11 or 12 in September (students graduating in June of the current school year cannot apply)
- Apply before spring break.

## SCHOLARSHIPS, AWARDS & BURSARIES

- Available throughout the year
- Many (but not all) will require excellent academic achievement
- All will require school, community service or extracurricular activities

January 15 UBC application deadline

**January 31** SFU & UVIC application deadline

March 1 UNBC application deadline
